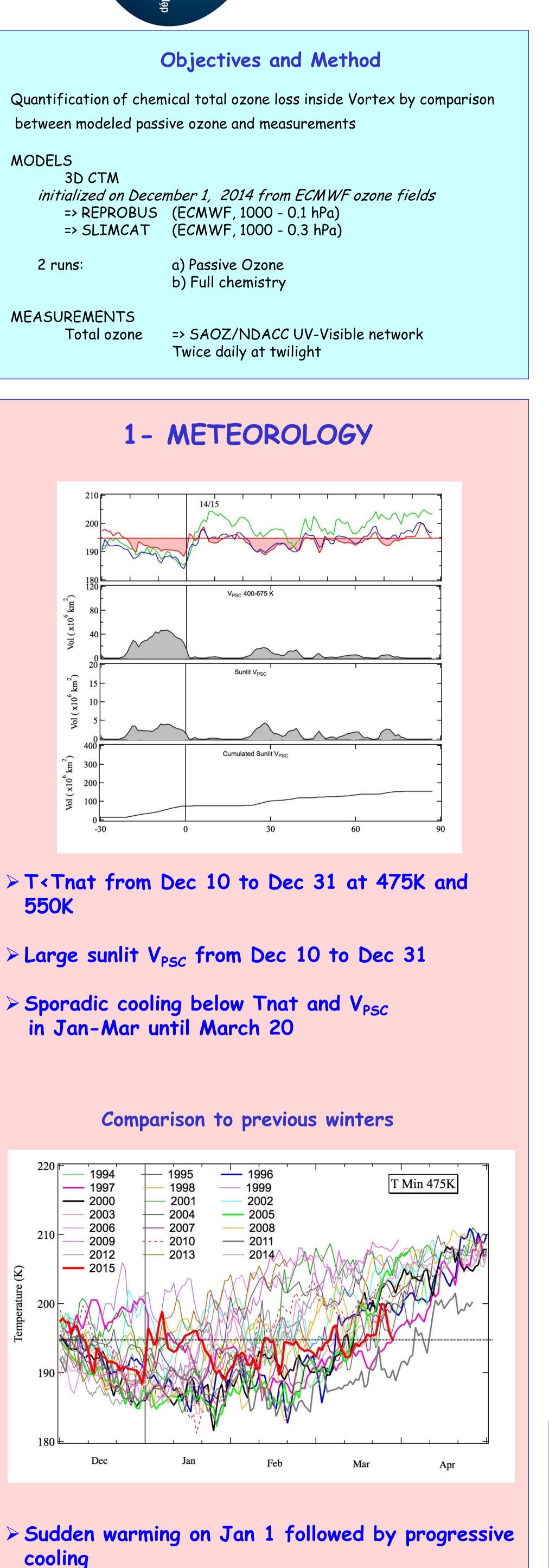

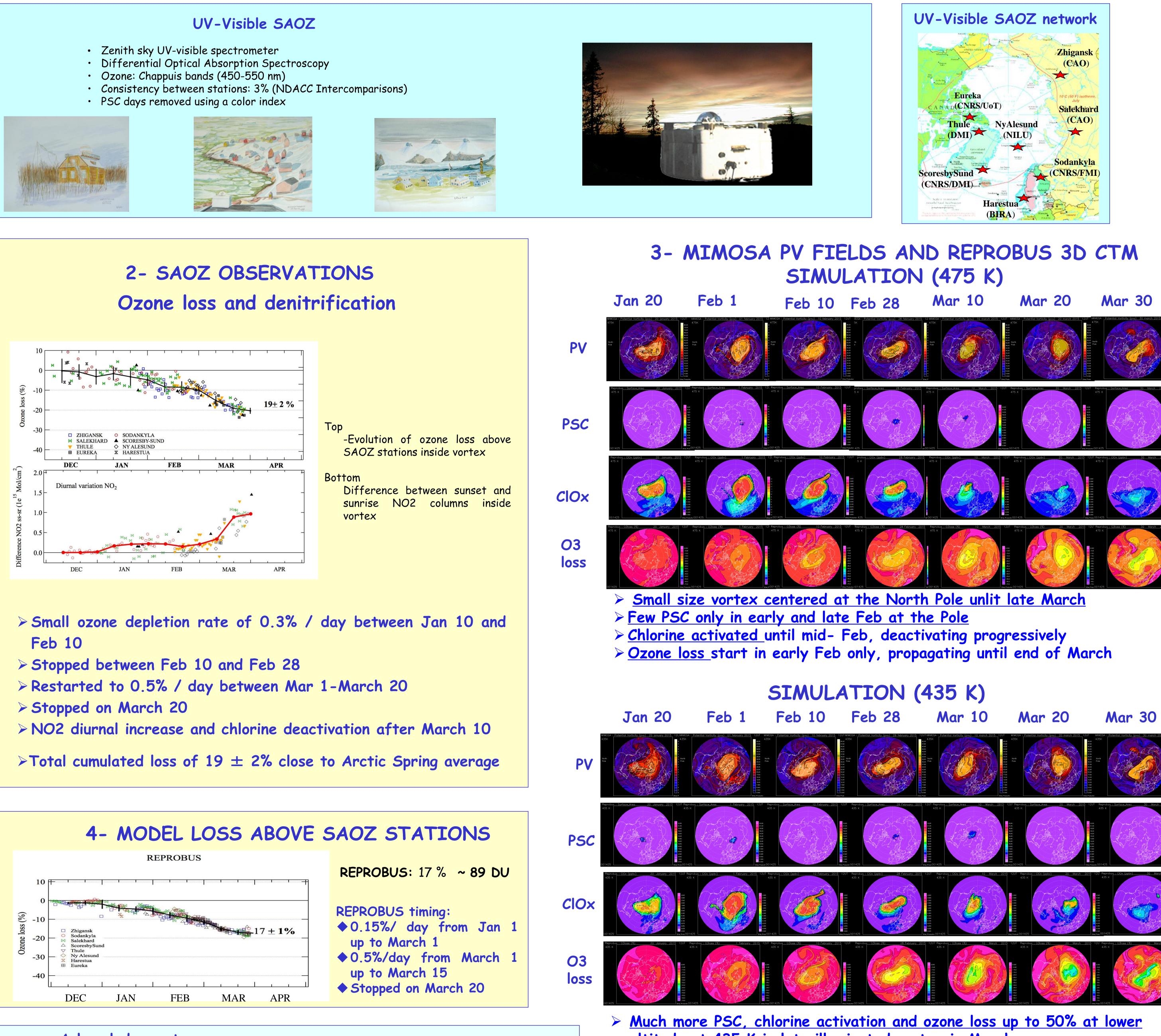

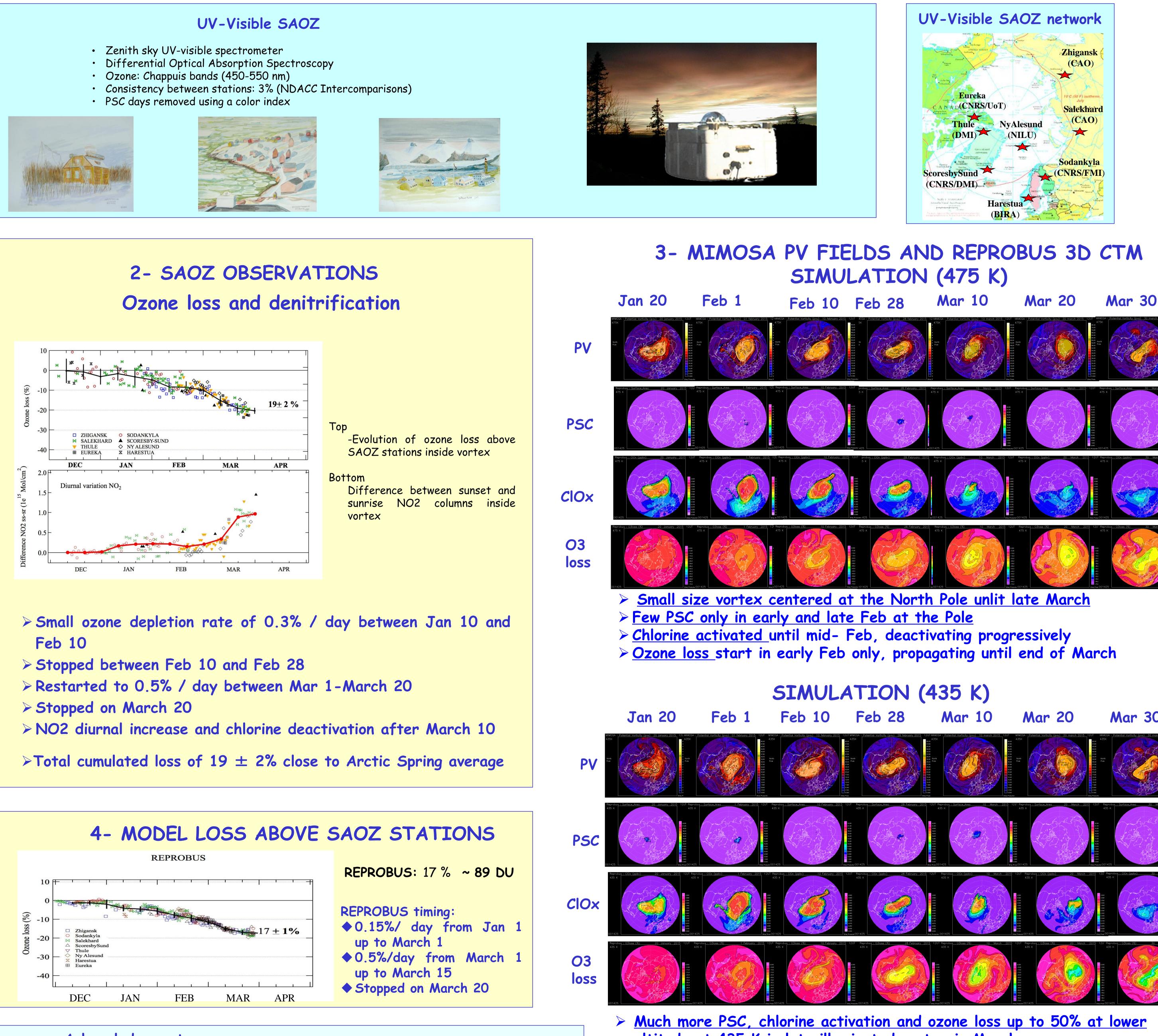




> Cold period in March compared to other winters

> Final warming after March 20



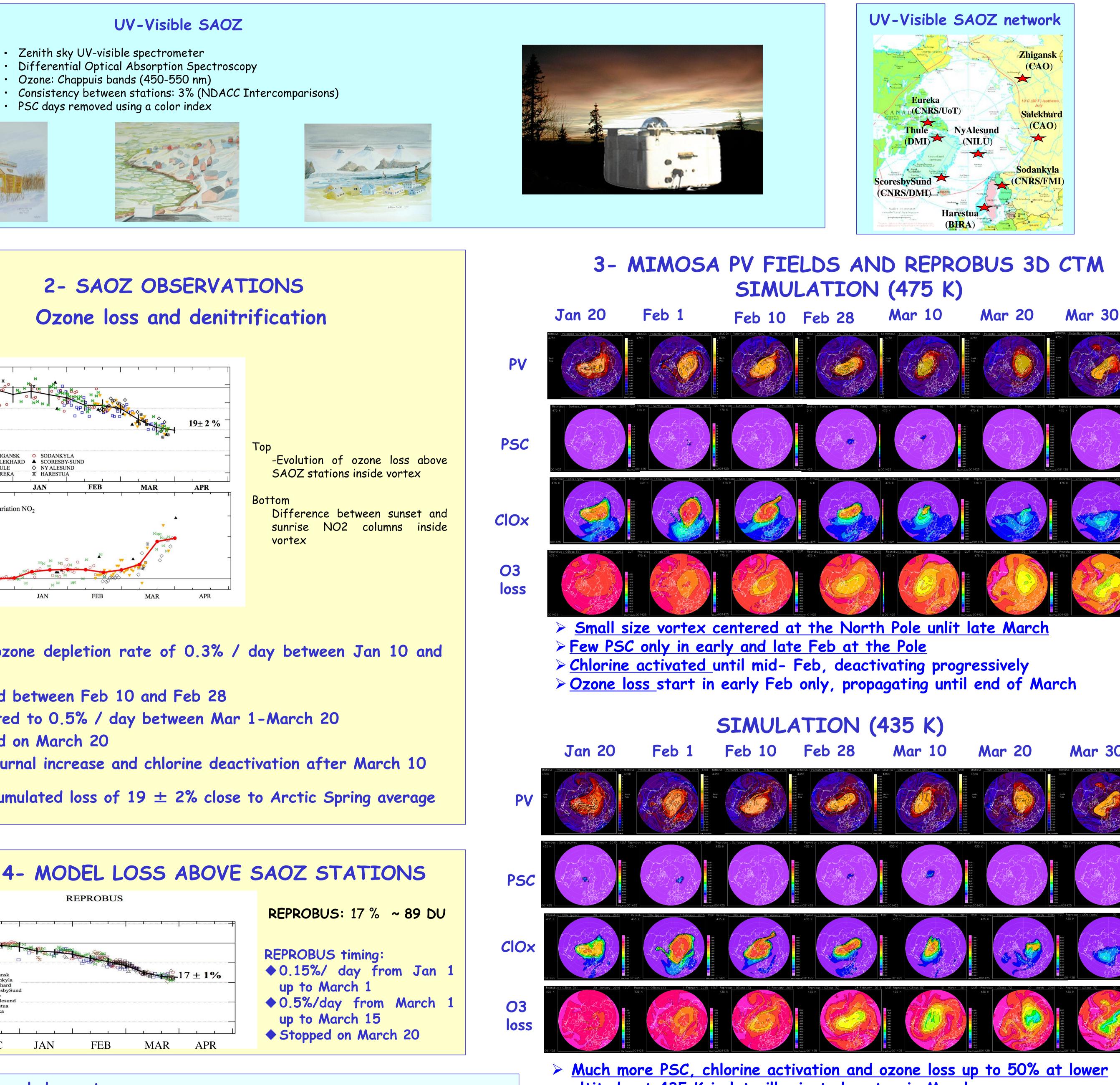

CONCLUSION WINTER 2014/2015:

- > Long lasting vortex
- > 19% loss due to vortex duration until March 20
- > Less de-activation at lower altitude (435 K)

> Total ozone loss of 19% close to average depletion in the Arctic > Maximum destruction at lower altitude (435 K) than usual (475-550 K)
