Max spectral resolution 0.5 cm⁻¹
320 x 256 pixels ; FOV: 6.4 × 5.1°

 Retrieval of 1 image = 7 days of calculation on Ciclad (IPSL computers) for SO₂ micro-window - Very good quality of retrieval with reduced $\chi^2 \leq 5$

Dataset from IMAGETNA campaign:

- 6 200 images
- 116 millions of pixels

Massive retrieval : results

Tested dataset pixels classified and images of SO₂ SCD retrieved using the library.

~ 15% of missing classes in the library (pixels in blue) mostly in dense plume part.
