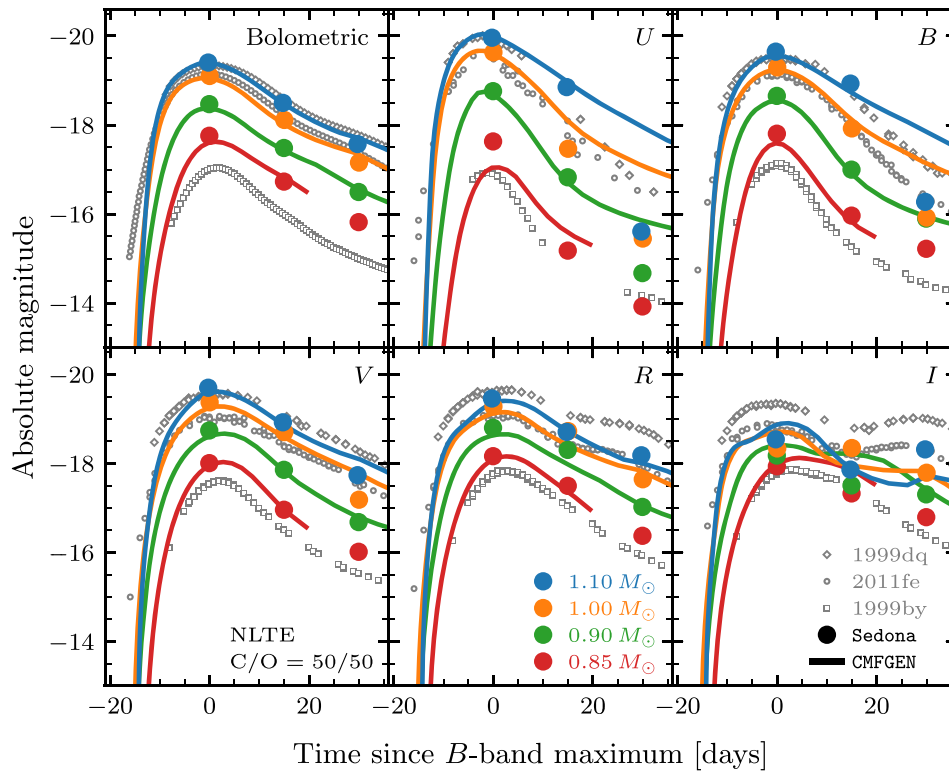

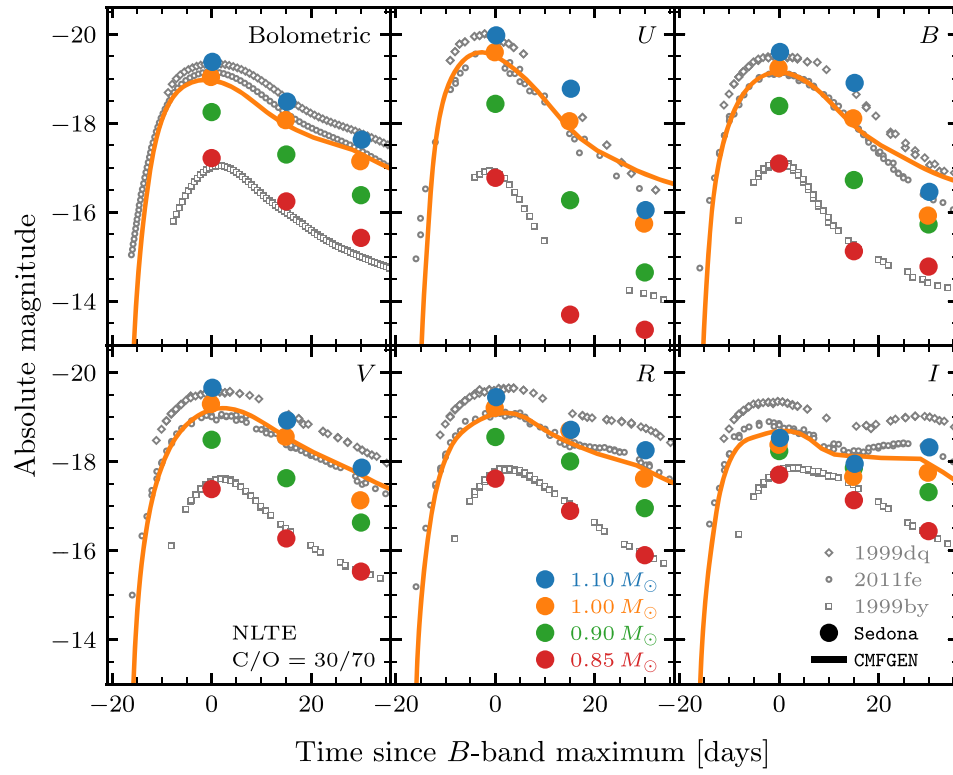

**Figure 2.** Multiband non-LTE light curves of 50/50 C/O mass ratio WD detonations. Masses are as labeled, with brighter peak *B*-band magnitudes as the mass increases. CMFGEN results are represented by solid lines; Sedona snapshots are demarcated with circles. Open diamonds, circles, and squares show observations of SNe 1999dq, 2011fe, and 1999by, respectively. Note that the observed “bolometric” light curves only consider UVOIR flux and are thus up to ~20% lower than the true bolometric luminosities.
